The Just Shall Live By _____.

Rom 1:17 *For therein is the righteousness of God revealed from faith to faith: as it is written, The just shall live by faith. KJV*

Hebrews 5:12-14 ¹² *For when for the time ye ought to be teachers, ye have need that one teach you again which be the first principles of the oracles of God; and are become such as have need of milk, and not of strong meat. ¹³ For every one that useth milk is unskilful in the word of righteousness: for he is a babe. ¹⁴ But strong meat belongeth to them that are of full age, even those who by reason of use have their senses *exercised to discern both good and evil. {The Passion Translation}*

Hebrews 12:11 *Now no chastening for the present seemeth to be joyous, but grievous: nevertheless afterward it yieldeth the peaceable fruit of righteousness unto them which are exercised thereby.*

The word is nigh thee, even in thy mouth, and in thy heart: that is, the word of faith, which we preach; 9 That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. 10 For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.*

Faith is released by acting on what you have heard, or simply by doing God's word.

James 2:26 *For as the body without the spirit is dead, so faith without works is dead also.*

You activate, or set your faith into _____ or action by doing what He says.

James 1: 5-8 *5 If any of you lack wisdom, let him ask of God, that giveth to all men liberally, and upbraideth not; and it shall be given him. 6 But let him ask in faith, nothing wavering. For he that wavereth is like a wave of the sea driven with the wind and tossed. 7 For let not that man think that he shall receive any thing of the Lord. 8 A double minded man is unstable in all his ways.*

Matt 7:24-29 *24 Therefore whosoever heareth these sayings of mine, and doeth them, I will liken him unto a wise man, which built his house upon a rock: 25 And the rain descended, and the floods came, and the winds blew, and beat upon that house; and it fell not: for it was founded upon a rock.*

26 And every one that heareth these sayings of mine, and doeth them not, shall be likened unto a foolish man, which built his house upon the sand: 27 And the rain descended, and the floods came, and the winds blew, and beat upon that house; and it fell: and great was the fall of it. 28 And it came to pass, when Jesus had ended these sayings, the people were astonished at his doctrine: 29 For he taught them as one having authority, and not as the scribes.

In this parable both the wise man and the foolish men _____ the word of God but only the wise man _____ it.

Def: *pistis* (pis'-tis); a _____ *persuasion, a conviction* the truthfulness of God

Prov 16:23 *The heart of the wise teacheth his mouth, and addeth learning to his lips.*
(KJV)

Mark 11:23-26 *23 For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not *doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith. (Notice it does not say, "He shall have whatsoever he beleiveth. It says he shall whatsoever he saith)*

24 Therefore I say unto you, what things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them.

The word doubt here is not just flat out rejecting what God says (that's unbelief) but rather it's choosing between two things. –

Shall not **"Doubt"** –DEF:- *to differ*, to withdraw from, to judge between two, **to contend with two**. To **hesitate**. Heb 11:1 Faith is now!

Matthew 15:8 *This people draweth nigh unto me with their mouth, and honoureth me with their lips; but their heart is far from me.* Ezek 33:31-32 31

"If you can teach people to respond from their hearts you can help them". Bro Hagin

1. Training Wheel # 1 is the Walk

Our love walk carries more weight in our physical being than we think. Galatians 5:6

If you say you are believing God for something that you know will be harmful to another person your FAITH WILL WORK!!!!

Romans 13:10-14 (KJV) *Love worketh **no** ill to his neighbour: therefore love is the fulfilling of the law.* {Mark11:25 forgiveness.}

Why? You have violated a greater law than faith - What - Love! Your faith cannot, will not work outside of love! Be kind to one another, gentle, tender hearted, why haven't we developed ourselves to respond from our heart as a habit? Eph 4:32 Love is far greater than Faith (now abideth faith, hope and love & the greatest of these is LOVE

Great Faith Requires Great Love!

II Th 1:3 *We are bound to thank God always for you, brethren, as it is meet, because that your faith groweth exceedingly, and the charity of every one of you all toward each other aboundeth;* (KJV)

Your faith will not grow any further than your commitment to walking in Love!

2. Being a Thankfull, Grateful, Person:

You will only be thankful when you believe that someone has _____ something for you. Hooking your mouth up to what you believe!

2 Cor 4:13 *We having the same spirit of faith, according as it is written, believed, and therefore have*

I spoken; we also believe, and therefore speak;

Ps 100:4 *Enter into his gates with thanksgiving, and into his courts with praise: be thankful unto him, and bless his name.* (KJV)

Don't hook up our _____ to our senses.

We are Word people! Lets not just be word people in the areas we want to be word people.

2 Tim 3:1-5 *This know also, that in the last days perilous times shall come. 2 For men shall be lovers of their own selves, covetous, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy, 3 Without natural affection, trucebreakers, false accusers, incontinent, fierce, despisers of those that are good, 4 Traitors, heady, highminded, lovers of pleasures more than lovers of God; 5 Having a form of godliness, but denying the power thereof: from such turn away.* (KJV)

3. in Tongues:

1 Cor 14:14 *For if I pray in an unknown tongue, my spirit prayeth, but my understanding is unfruitful.* (KJV). **Jude 1:20**

How do I know this is a training wheel? Because I have to hook my mouth up with my heart to be able to pray I have tell my mind to shut up
