Mark 11:22- 25 ²² And Jesus answering saith unto them, Have faith in God.

²³ For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith. ²⁴ Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them. ²⁵ And when ye stand praying, forgive, if ye have ought against any: that your Father also which is in heaven may forgive you your trespasses.

KJV ²² And Jesus answering saith unto them, Have faith in God. "Have the God kind of faith" Wycliffe **Bible (WYC)** Have ye the faith of God; **Young's Literal Translation (YLT)** Have faith of God;

"There is a difference between having faith ___ God, and having and exercising the faith ___ God"

The kind of faith that spoke the universe into existence is given to us. The Lord places His faith (His kind of faith) within our hearts.

What did Jesus do? **Mark 11:**¹² And on the morrow, when they were come from Bethany, he was hungry: ¹³ And seeing a fig tree afar off having leaves, he came, if haply he might find anything thereon: and when he came to it, he found nothing but leaves; for the time of figs was not yet.¹⁴ And Jesus answered and *said* unto it, **No man eat fruit of thee hereafter for ever.** And his disciples heard it. ¹⁹ And when even was come, he went out of the city. ²⁰ And in the morning, as they passed by, they saw the fig tree dried up from the roots. ²¹ And Peter calling to remembrance saith unto him, Master, behold, the fig tree which thou cursedst is withered away.

JESUS _____: verse 14 – said -they had all they need to have faith – "they heard the words of Jesus." – JESUS SAID TO THE FIG TREE FAITH WAS IN HEART AND

HIS MOUTH! Verse 19 – they saw It was withered up from where? The roots – can you “see”. The roots usually? No. the roots are in the unseen realm. The POWER OF FAITH IN THE WORD OF GOD WORKS IN THE _____ REALM!

God Gave Us _____ Faith: Romans 12:3 *For I say, through the grace given unto me, to every man that is among you, not to think of himself more highly than he ought to think; but to think soberly, according as God hath dealt to every man the measure of faith.*

Two Central Truths: **Two places where Faith must be found!**

1) Faith is of the _____ or Man Believes With His Heart.

Romans 10:8-10 ⁸ *But what saith it? The word is nigh thee, even in thy mouth, and in thy heart: that is, the word of faith, which we preach; ⁹ That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. ¹⁰ For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation. If faith is of the heart (and it is) then why are so many people trying to convince their heads to trust God, to believe God.*

“It is possible to believe with your heart and doubt with your head and still receive!”

2. Faith Must Be in Your _____.

2 Cor 5: 13 *We having the same spirit of faith, according as it is written, I believed, and therefore have I spoken; we also believe, and therefore speak;*

Matthew 12:33- 37 ³³ *Either make the tree good, and his fruit good; or else make the tree corrupt, and his fruit corrupt: for the tree is known by his fruit. ³⁴ O generation of vipers, how can ye, being evil, speak good things? for out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaketh. ³⁵ A good man out of the good treasure of the heart bringeth forth good things: and an evil man out of the evil treasure bringeth forth evil things.*

³⁶ *But I say unto you, That every idle word that men shall speak, they shall give account*

thereof in the day of judgment. ³⁷ For by thy words thou shalt be justified, and by thy words thou shalt be condemned.

Def: Faith - *pistis*] *primarily, firm persuasion," a conviction based upon hearing (akin to peitho, "to persuade"), is used in the NT always of "faith in God or Christ, or things spiritual."*

Luke 12:32 (KJV) *Fear not, little flock; for it is your Father's good pleasure to give you the kingdom.*

Psalm 84:11 (KJV) ¹¹ *For the LORD God is a sun and shield: the LORD will give grace and glory: no good thing will he withhold from them that walk uprightly.*
