Getting the Word In Your Heart. Romans 10:10

1) Faith is of the heart

2) Faith is released by the mouth

Psalms 119:9-10 ⁹ *Wherewithal shall a young man cleanse his way? by taking heed thereto according to thy word.* ¹⁰ *With my whole heart have I sought thee: O let me not wander from thy commandments.* ¹¹ *Thy word have I hid in mine heart, that I might not sin against thee.*

The word that has been hidden in your heart the Word of God that you KNOW! John 8:31 & 32

The Word Rides the Elevator!!!!

Proverbs 4:20-23 ²⁰ *My son, attend to my words; incline thine ear unto my sayings.* ²¹ *Let them not depart from thine eyes; keep them in the midst of thine heart.* ²² *For they are life unto those that find them, and health to all their flesh.* ²³ *Keep thy heart with all diligence; for out of it are the issues of life.* ²⁴ *Put away from thee a froward mouth, and perverse lips put far from thee.*

Youth mouth is the elevator that the words ride on to gain access into your heart.

What you say will be planted and rooted in your heart.

Your mouth determines your harvest!

Whatever is in your heart in abundance will come out!

No one has more authority in your life than you do!

When you speak the word of God over yourself it is the greatest release of power your life.

Prov 18:21 *Death and life are in the power of the tongue: and they that love it shall eat the fruit thereof.*

Caleb:

Joshua 14:7-12 (KJV) ⁷ *Forty years old was I when Moses the servant of the LORD sent me from Kadeshbarnea to espy out the land; and I brought him word again as it was in mine heart. ⁸ Nevertheless my brethren that went up with me made the heart of the people melt: but I wholly followed the LORD my God. ⁹ And Moses sware on that day, saying, Surely the land whereon thy feet have trodden shall be thine inheritance, and thy children's for ever, because thou hast wholly followed the LORD my God.*

¹⁰ *And now, behold, the LORD hath kept me alive, as he said, these forty and five years, even since the LORD spake this word unto Moses, while the children of Israel wandered in the wilderness: and now, lo, I am this day fourscore and five years old. ¹¹ As yet I am as strong this day as I was in the day that Moses sent me: as my strength was then, even so is my strength now, for war, both to go out, and to come in.*

¹² *Now therefore give me this mountain, whereof the LORD spake in that day; for thou heardest in that day how the Anakims were there, and that the cities were great and fenced: if so be the LORD will be with me, then I shall be able to drive them out, **as the LORD said.***

Matthew 12:34 Jesus said *for out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaks.*

What is in your heart in abundance- Is it the word of God?
Here's how you can know.

"FULL OF FAITH"

Stephen a Man "full of faith":

Acts 6:2-5 ² Then the twelve called the multitude of the disciples unto them, and said, It is not reason that we should leave the word of God, and serve tables. ³ Wherefore, brethren, look ye out among you seven men of honest report, full of the Holy Ghost and wisdom, whom we may appoint over this business. ⁴ But we will give ourselves continually to prayer, and to the ministry of the word. ⁵ And the saying pleased the whole multitude: and they chose **Stephen, a man full of faith** and of the Holy Ghost, and Philip, and Prochorus, and Nicanor, and Timon, and Parmenas, and Nicolas a proselyte of Antioch:

**Now it would be unfair of the Word of God to say that a man was "full of faith" and not tell us how they knew it?
How did he get that way? – Amen...**

8 And **Stephen, full of faith** and power, did great wonders and miracles among the people. ⁹ Then there arose certain of the synagogue, which is called the synagogue of the Libertines, and Cyrenians, and Alexandrians, and of them of Cilicia and of Asia,

disputing with Stephen. ¹⁰ And they were not able to resist the wisdom and the spirit by which he spake. ¹¹ Then they suborned men, which said, We have heard him speak blasphemous words against Moses, and against God. ¹² And they stirred up the people, and the elders, and the scribes, and came upon him, and caught him, and brought him to the council,¹³ And set up false witnesses, which said, This man ceaseth not to speak blasphemous words against this holy place, and the law:¹⁴ For we have heard him say, that this Jesus of Nazareth shall destroy this place, and shall change the customs which Moses delivered us.¹⁵ And all that sat in the council, looking stedfastly on him, saw his face as it had been the face of an angel.

Stephen preaching Christ

7: ⁵⁴ When they heard these things, they were cut to the heart, and they gnashed on him with their teeth. ⁵⁵ But he, being full of the Holy Ghost, looked up stedfastly into heaven, and saw the glory of God, and Jesus standing on the right hand of God,⁵⁶ And said, Behold, I see the heavens opened, and the Son of man standing on the right hand of God.⁵⁷ Then they cried out with a loud voice, and stopped their ears, and ran upon him with one accord, ⁵⁸ And cast him out of the city, and stoned him: and the witnesses laid down their clothes at a young man's feet, whose name was Saul.⁵⁹ And they stoned Stephen, calling upon God, and saying, Lord Jesus, **receive my spirit.**

⁶⁰ And he kneeled down, and cried with a loud voice, **Lord, lay not this sin to their charge.** And when he had said this, he fell asleep.

Stephen was spirit conscious, more than body, flesh conscious.

“Receive my “Spirit”– he was speaking from his heart, Not his flesh, not his soul... Lord lay not this sin to their charge:

Stephen was a man full of faith because he had learned to hook up his mouth to his heart.

Proverbs 16:23 *The heart of the wise teacheth his mouth, and addeth learning to his lips.*

Jesus:

Luke 23:46 *And when Jesus had cried with a loud voice, he said, Father, into thy hands I commend my spirit: and having said thus, he gave up the ghost.*

34: *Then said Jesus, **Father, forgive them; for they know not what they do.** And they parted his raiment, and cast lots.*

“Lay not this sin to their charge” “Receive my Spirit”

James 1:21 *Wherefore lay apart all filthiness and superfluity of naughtiness, and receive with meekness the *engrafted word, which is able to save your souls.*

Young's Literal Translation: *wherefore having put aside all filthiness and superabundance of evil, in meekness be receiving the engrafted word, that is able to save your souls;*

I.E. Skin Graft: “graft - to began functioning normal”

*Engrafted is when two become one – when that which is grafted in is just as much a part of you as the rest

When the Word takes such a place of prominence in your life – it seems like it’s one with everything else in your life. No division, no separation- One! Cant tell your life and the word of God apart- you have received it an it has become one with the way you think, act, and speak!

Acting on the word prevents you from forgetting it.

James 1:22 *But be ye doers of the Word not hears only*

Matthew 7: Sand- Rock both heard both had storms one did one did not.
